Confirmation Superintendent	Coordinates Confirmation activities and teachers. Grades 6 - 8.
Confirmation teacher	Confirmation teaching is for a block of time no more than 10 weeks. Curriculum is provided. Grades 6 - 8. Substitutes also needed. Help with special projects too.
Confirmation mentor	A Confirmation mentor is an adult member who is paired with an 8th grade confirmation student to review specific materials to help them prepare for their Confirmation.
