2013 Golf Outing

25th PADS Season Coming To a Close

All Saints' 25th season as a PADS shelter will come to a close on April 27 with our traditional barbeque prepared and served by members of the Youth Group. A week later, **Friday May 3**, everyone who has contributed in any way to our ministry to the homeless is invited to a **Volunteer Appreciation** dinner in the Gathering Space.

"Even though we've been doing this for a quarter-century there is still a need," said Tom Germuska, co-site director for the shelter.

"With a month to go we've already cared for more individuals than all of the 2011-2012 season," he said

"Unfortunately we haven't worked our way out of this job."

Email invitations to everyone who participated in the operation of the shelter will be sent in early April. "Everyone includes shelter volunteers who worked face-to-face with the guests and cleaned

up on Sunday morning; the cooks and bakers who prepared the food that was served; members who shopped for lunch-meat, eggs and bacon or juice; and the Leadership Team who made sure everything ran smoothly," Tom said. If you helped and didn't get an email please contact Tom or Monika Fiedler, other co-site director.

The event will start with a meet-and-greet reception at 5:30 p.m. followed by a catered buffet dinner at 6:45 p.m. Pat Harrington, shelter director for Journeys | The Road Home, the agency which provides supportive services to the homeless in Northwest Cook County, is expected to make some remarks and members of the Leadership Team will be recognized.
