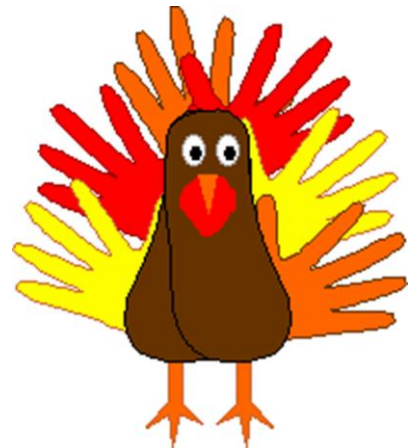

PADS ministry begins 26th season Oct. 5

All Saints' ministry to homeless persons in our community resumes this month—our 26th season. We will welcome homeless quests into our home every Saturday night during the cold-weather months starting Oct. 5 until April 26, 2014.

And when the shelter re-opens there will be a variety of opportunities for members to help. These include:

- Working face-to-face with guests on one of four shifts each weekend
- Cooking or shopping to help feed our guests
- Helping clean up on Sunday morning so the rooms needed for the shelter are ready for Sunday School
- And a few volunteer-coordinators who can help the shelter run smoothly throughout the season.

In addition, there is a need for clothing and toiletries to meet the needs of our guests. We need both men's and women's underwear in all sizes as well as socks – see Socks Sunday article for details. Gently-used jeans, sweaters and sweatshirts also are frequently requested. Cash donations also are welcome. Use a pew envelope and mark the special-offering line PADS.

Experienced volunteers are invited to put their “name in the book” (on the narthex table) for the dates and shifts when they can help. There is a particular need for male volunteers on the 8:15- 11 p.m. and 11 p.m.-3 a.m. shifts. Adults and high school juniors and seniors who would like to help in the shelter must attend new-volunteer training conducted by

Journeys | The Road Home. A list of dates and times when training is offered is also on the narthex table and online at www.journeystheroadhome.org No training is required to help with clean-up on Sunday morning.

“The Book” also has information about the meals planned for each night the shelter is open. Cooks are welcome to use their favorite family recipe for the food they cook or pick one from the recipe box near the sign-up book.

PADS closet needs clothing, toiletries

Guests in our PADS shelter frequently request a variety of clothing items during their stay. Sometimes it's as simple as a pair of clean, dry socks; at other times they need a warm sweater or a pair of jeans. Although we it's impossible to fulfill all of their needs, to the extent possible we try to provide the basics.

We'll re-stock our PADS closet with clothing and toiletries on "Socks Sunday," October 13. The

closet was depleted during the summer as we provided clothing for Summer Suppers guests.

A "shopping list" was included as a bulleting insert Sept. 29 and Oct. 6. In addition to socks we especially need donations of men's and women's underwear in all sizes; thermal underwear; duffle bags and adult back packs; as well as disposable razors and travel-size shaving cream, deodorant and facial tissue. (We've

run out of room to store the soap, shampoo and conditioner you brought back from vacation.)

We also can use donations of plastic storage bags, either sandwich- or gallon-sized; any variety of unrefrigerated salad dressing; canned regular or decaffeinated coffee; and single-serve packets of hot chocolate.
